1. Bringing your child in for an hour, one on one lesson and barn time with a Counselor each day of the week. Using the camp booklet and receiving the T-shirt. No price change.

2. Attend the camp with the outline below.

Please also see the additional release and contact information sheet that needs to be filled out.

Thank you for attending Heberle Stables summer camp. In order to make the week go by smoothly there are a few things to look out for:

- Bring a mask for campers to wear and please wear a mask during drop off.
- Campers will be kept in groups of six with the same counselor/instructor for the week.
- Be sure to send your child with adequate amounts of fluid, a snack, and a packed lunch.
- It could be very hot; children are more than welcome to change into shorts and sneakers after their riding lessons.
- Baseball hats are also encouraged as a method of cleanliness and to keep your child cool.
- Drop off time is at 9am, if your child is doing half-day camp, pick up is at noon. If your child is staying for a full day, pick up time is at 4pm. (if you need before or after care, please notify us)
- Please **Do Not** speed up the driveway, there are lots of kids and animals that live here.
- While the dogs are friendly, they are “working” on the farm. Please tell your children to leave the dogs and cats alone.

Each day upon arrival,

- Park cars (past the 2 houses) stay by car until Counselor greets you.
- Temperature taken of child, payment and paperwork completion.
- Child brought into the barn, hands sanitized.
- Join the group assigned to you.
- Personal belongings are put in a separate container in the barn.
- Camp begins! Masks worn except while on horse or during a break when all are at 6 foot distance.

Throughout the day, hands will be washed, equipment and barn sanitized.

Departure

- Hands sanitized, worksheet brought home.
- Drive up and wait in line in front of the indoor ring, campers will come to the vehicle with Counselor.

Monday and Tuesday

Children will have a riding lesson. Throughout the day they will learn the basics of horse care and safety around the barn. We will also begin our week-long horse project.

Wednesday

In the morning we will have our normal riding lesson. In the afternoon, we will have water day.(water day can be every afternoon if hot and campers choose) If children plan to get wet we suggest bringing a bathing suit, towel, and a change of clothes. For safety reasons shoes must be worn at all times. They can be water shoes, but please no flip flops. Our water day activities include a slip-n'-slide.

Thursday

Another lesson in the morning to polish up for Friday's Horse Show! By this time your child will be schooled enough to demonstrate what they have learned. Ask a counselor on Wednesday for the approximate time of your child's lesson. If you cannot make it Friday, contact us to schedule a time to watch. In the afternoon we will be working on a craft and bareback riding.

Friday

Horse Show Day! Come and watch your child demonstrate what they have learned during their riding lesson. **To wrap up the week we will have a pizza party in the afternoon. Please send your child to camp with \$3.00 for pizza and soda. *Possibly canceling pizza.*

Ask your child which group they are in for the timing of their showtime! 9:30/10:30/11:30.
