



### **COVID 19 Guidelines - Rides - Stage One**

May 14, 2020

Gov. Cuomo has now allowed us to open! Of course with restrictions and protocol to follow. Heberle's will not be opened up fully, but are going to reopen the lesson/Ride program.

Due to the current circumstances with COVID-19, we will be implementing precautions to follow disinfecting and social distancing guidelines per the CDC for our Lesson Program.

1. We ask that when you arrive for your lesson/Ride during stage one that you **do not** enter the stables but, wait by the front entrance of the South barn.
2. Have your mask with you to wear, but they're not required while riding.
3. Please take your temperature prior to arrival. We have a non contact thermometer at the barn.
4. If you do not feel well, stay home.
5. Please disinfect your hands when you arrive. We will have a station outside the barn for you to use if you do not have your own.
6. Lesson/Riding horses will be tacked up and brought out for you. The saddle and reins will be cleaned in between each rider by one of the staff members.
7. Please hand payment to the instructor/Guide.
8. Only one person/parent to accompany the rider. No spectators.

Our staff will continue to wipe down and disinfect all equipment used for each evening and morning to ensure that all equipment is ready for students when they arrive each day.
