



COVID 19 Guidelines - Camp

Due to the current circumstances with COVID-19, we will be implementing precautions to follow disinfecting and social distancing guidelines per the CDC.

We ask that all parents keep their campers home if they are not feeling well or if they have a fever and that you check your campers temperature prior to drop off each day.

When you arrive for drop off there will be a counselor waiting to check in your camper. They will ask if the camper has had any respiratory symptoms and will take your campers temperature.

Masks are required. While on the horse, riders do not need to wear masks.

Once the camper is cleared to enter camp we will take them to drop off their belongings, each camper will have their own box that is labeled with their name for their items. Hand sanitizer is always available and hand washing stations.

We will be breaking into small groups based on their riding times (5-10 campers in each group). These groups will be staying together from arrival to dismissal. Only one group will be allowed in an area at a time to minimize contact in a large group setting.

When leaving each station, items used will be wiped down and sanitized before moving onto the next activity and students will be able to wash/sanitize their hands. As well as, all tack will be wiped down after each use.

If a child becomes sick during the camp day, we will remove the student from the group and move them to different parts of the stables with one counselor while their parents are contacted for pick up. The areas that the camper had been in contact with will be wiped down and sanitized.

We will also be providing personal crayons for each camper which they can take home at the end of the week. That will be kept in their personal bin throughout the week.

Our staff disinfects the inside of the barn minimum of twice daily.

Most activities will be outside. In the barn it is well ventilated with opened windows/doors.
